## **Activating Questions:**

- 1. Spend 5 minutes writing what you know about any Canadian pipeline protests that you have been made aware of in the past couple of years. You can also write what you already know about the parties who are involved; what you think you know; or what you've heard about the pipeline protests.
- 2. Take a few minutes to write down questions you may have, including what you're confused or unsure about, or what you want to know.

3. Lastly, add a personal reflection about protests in general. How do you feel about them? Should we have the right to protest? At what cost? Should we have the right to disrupt the Canadian economy with those protests? Are these kind of protests an effective way of resolving conflicts between two sides? If not, what might be some alternative options instead of protesting?
